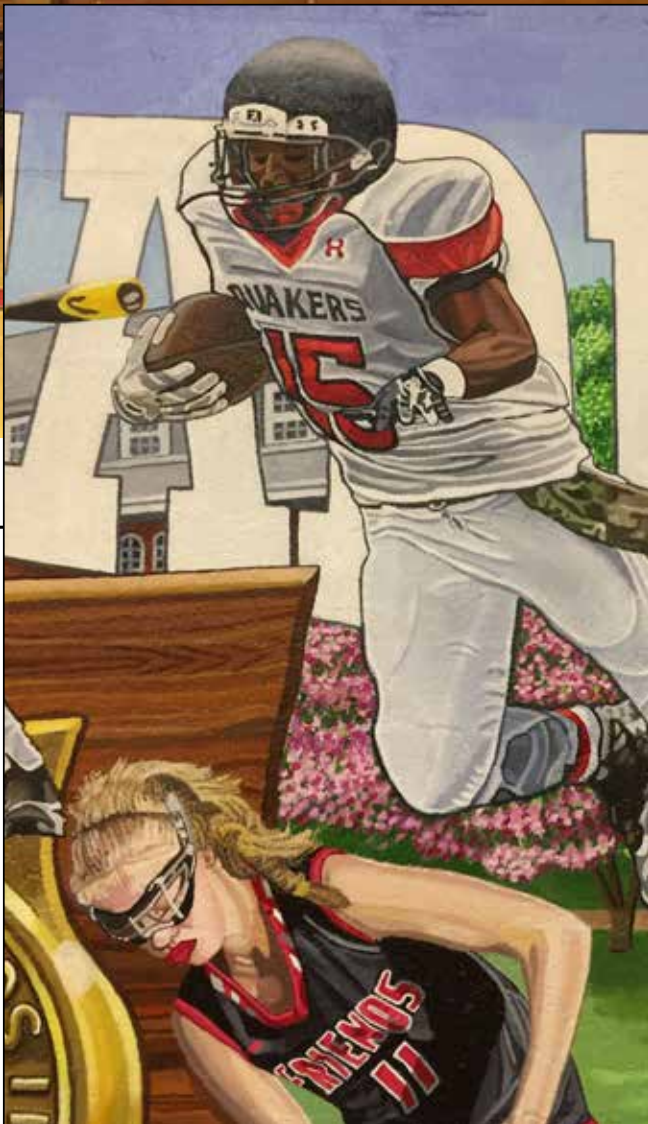

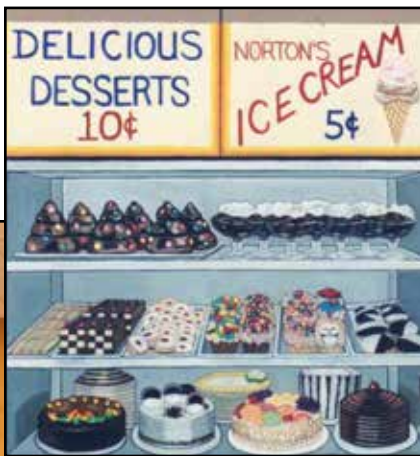

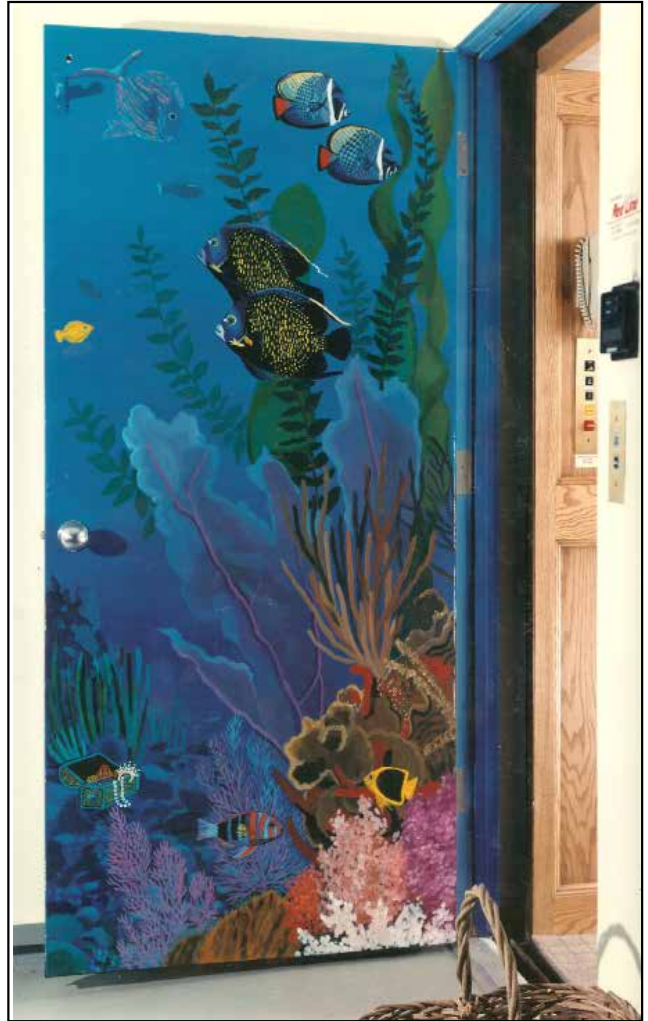


Interior Murals For Residential Buildings

An entirely different mood can be set for entertainment venues. Point of sale graphics may be integrated as well.

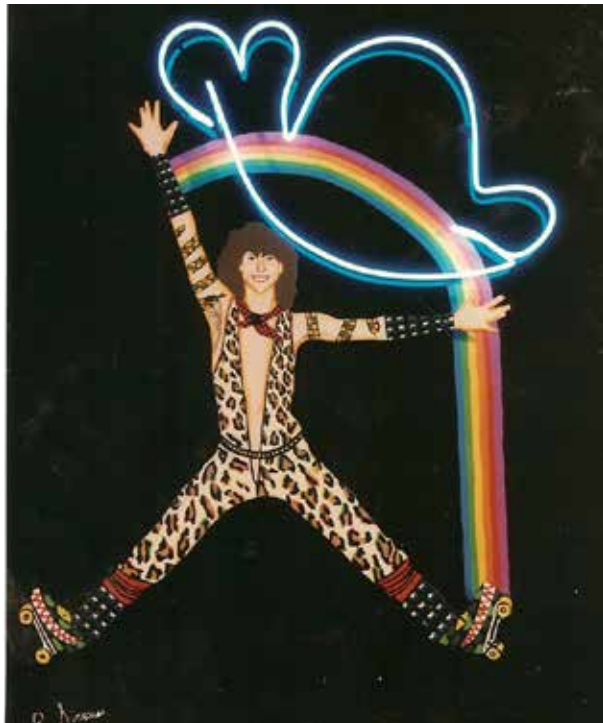

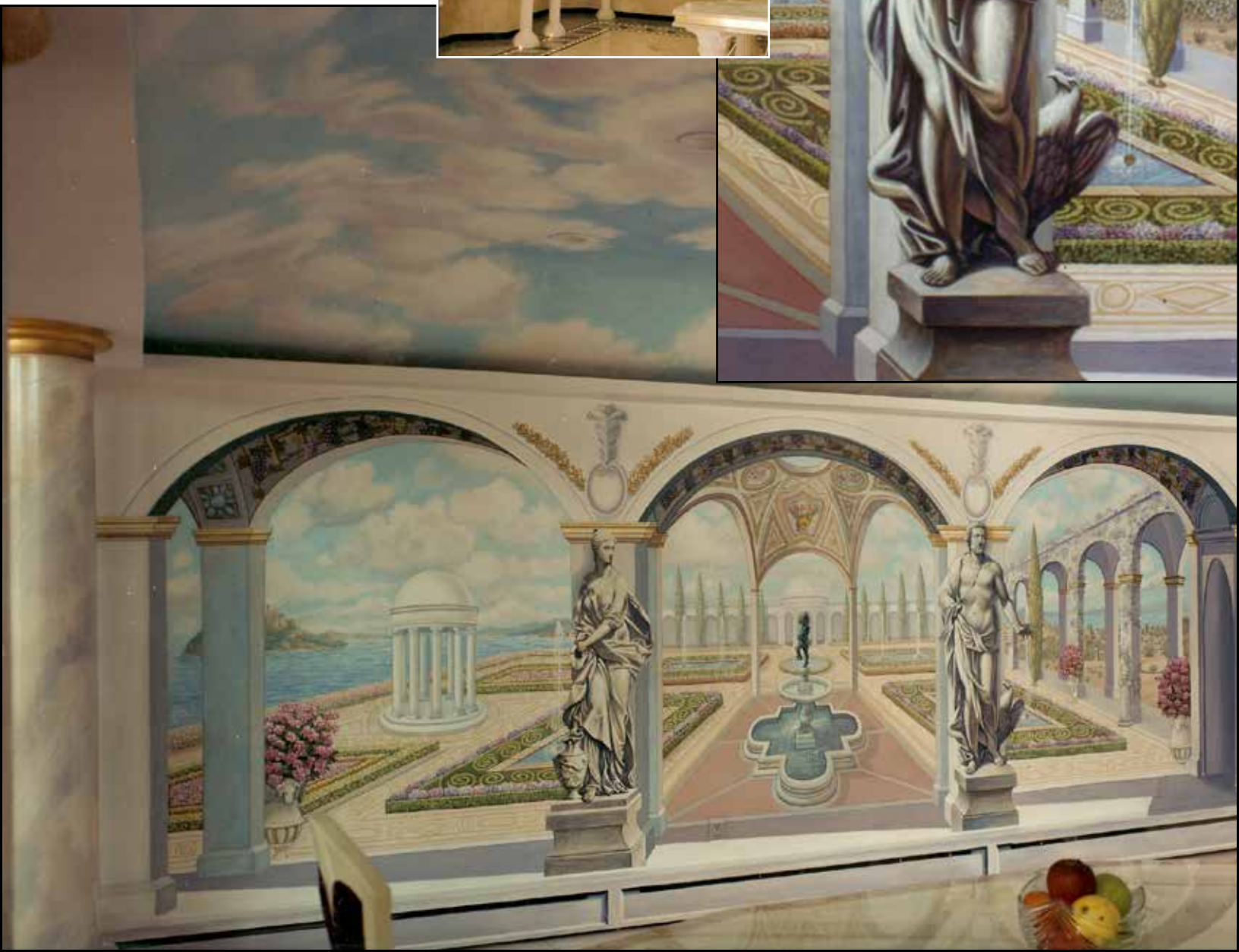

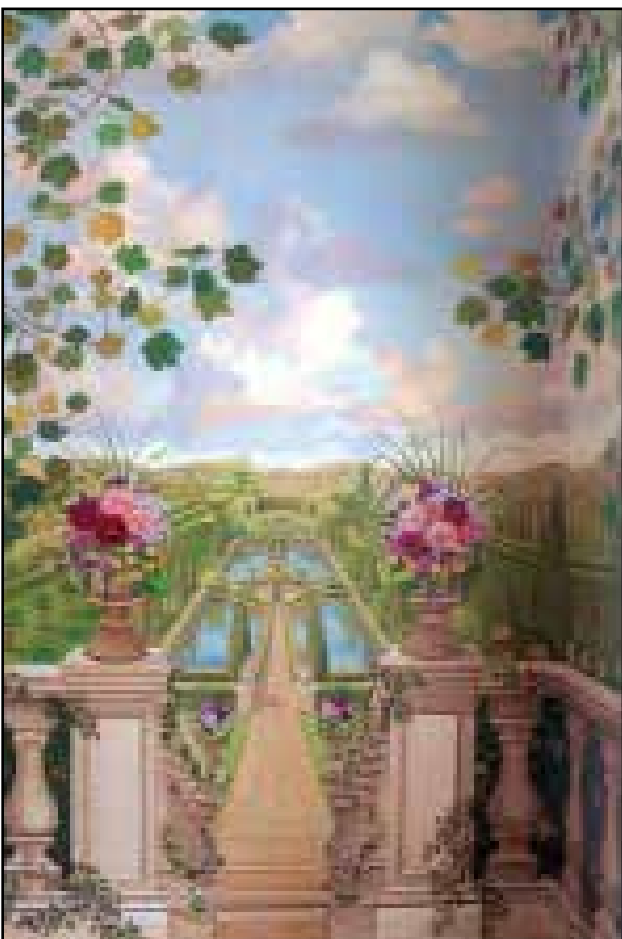

Interior Murals & Ceiling Work

The management of a professional office building on Broadhollow Road in Melville, Long Island brought me onboard to create a solarium setting for a common space used for relaxation and lunch for staff and visitors.

The architectural team had the concept of the space, shown above, right. Based on the artist's conception drawing, I created an 'outdoor' environment indoors. The 15' tall ceiling and 4,000 square foot space has a feeling of natural light and infinite height. It will come to life with live plantings and human activity. This museum quality ceiling work adds year-round value to the commercial property.



Murals on Room Dividers & Window Treatments

Folding screens, room dividers, doors, cabinetry and window treatments provide opportunities for murals where no wall space in a room to do a mural exists.



Murals can be painted on vertical blinds, window shades and curtains to continue a theme from wall to window treatment.



Paneled screens and accordion room dividers can also be painted and are ideally suited and functional applications for restaurants, catering halls, hotels, meeting rooms and retail spaces

Murals on Furniture & Cabinetry

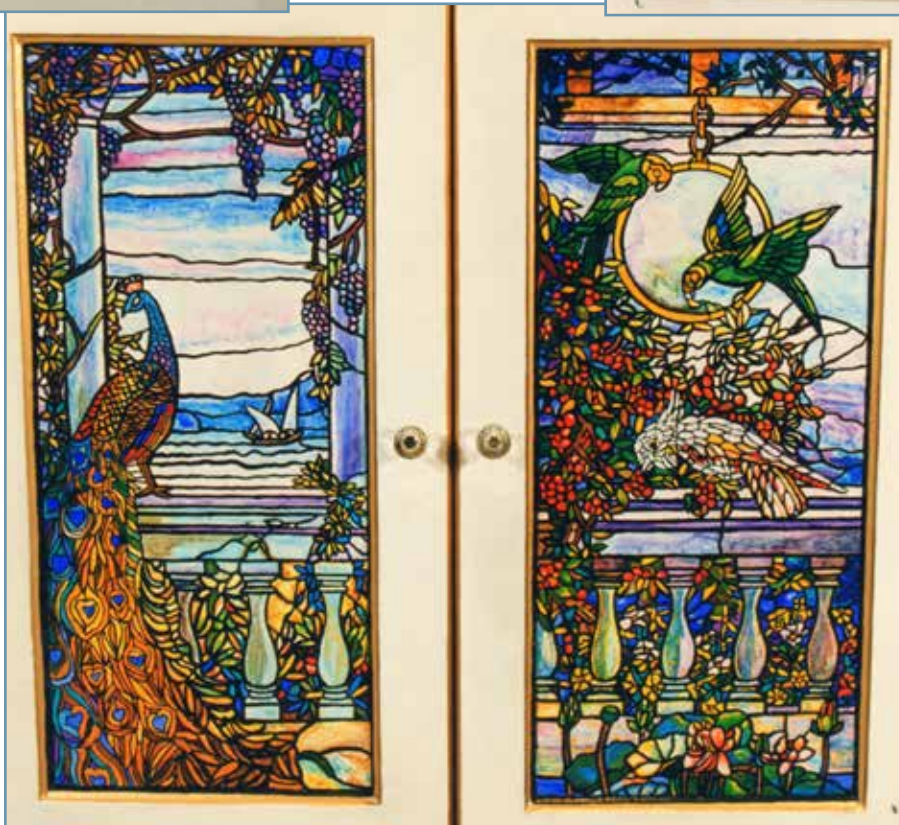

A life-less built in medicine cabinet painted to create the illusion of a window showing a garden view. This brightens up an otherwise dark interior space.



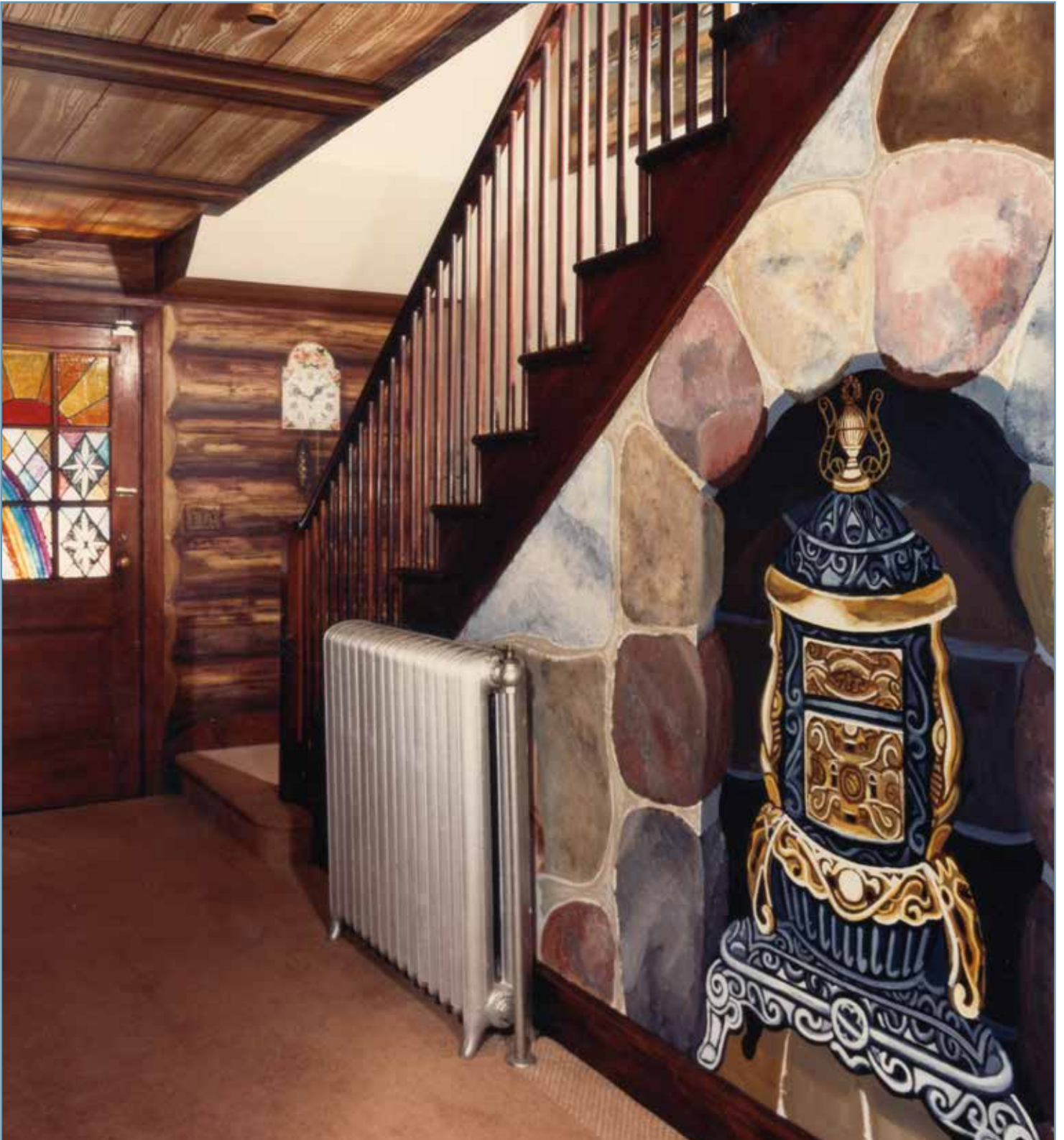
